Rules for regular season play:

Games will be played at Chula Vista High School, and Paradise Hills Penn Athletic Field. Standings for the regular season will be based on the **ten point system**; six points for a win, three point for a tie, zero points for a loss, one point for shutout, plus 1 point for each goal scored (up to maximum of 3 points). Winning coaches must report the outcome of the game to the Division Representative, before 5:00 PM on the Sunday following the game. Email: hector-patty-willie@netscape.com **Only Teams that complete volunteer assignments are eligible for post-season.**

The home team is listed first on the schedule and has the choice of sides of the field. The referee provides the game ball. Properly completed lineup cards, and registration forms must be present prior to the start of the game.

Coaching shall be done only by the designated coaches, who may coach only from the side of the field designated for their team. A team that cannot begin play within 10 minutes of the scheduled start of the game shall forfeit the game. A forfeited game will be scored 1 - 0. No "scrimmage" game shall be played after forfeiture.

Only the home field Commissioner may make the decision to cancel games for rain or heat. Coaches will be notified as soon as possible of any cancellation.

Teams scheduled for the first game of the day must report to the field to set up goals and flags one hour prior to game time. Teams scheduled for the last game of the day must help put goals and flags away. **Every Team must clean up their sideline after each game.**
