ALL PLAYERS MUST PLAY HALF of the GAME!!

Rules for regular season play:

Last Teams scheduled on field must put away Goals (Field 6- 1:00 PM GAMES).

NO SCORE OR STANDINGS WILL BE KEPT

REGARDLESS OF START TIME, TEAMS MUST BE OFF OF THE FIELD AT 10 MINUTES BEFORE THE START HOUR OF THE NEXT GAME.

GAMES are 20 minute halves (10 minute quarters between substitutions). Game MUST be completed by 10 minutes before the next hour. (Games at 9 AM must be completed by 9:50, and so on..)

Games will be played at Chula Vista High School Fields. Each team must supply one adult referee for the game. No games the second week of the season for Photos.

The home team is listed first on the schedule and has the choice of sides of the field. The home team must change jerseys if there is a conflict in uniform colors. The referee provides the game ball. Properly completed lineup cards, and registration forms must be present prior to the start of the game.

Coaching shall be done only by the designated coaches, who may coach only from the side of the field designated for their team. A team that cannot begin play within 10 minutes of the scheduled start of the game shall forfeit the game. No "scrimmage" game shall be played after forfeiture.

Only the Commissioner may make the decision to cancel games for rain or heat. Coaches will be notified as soon as possible of any cancellation.

Teams scheduled for the first game of the day must report to the field to set up goals and flags one hour prior to game time. Teams scheduled for the last game of the day must help put goals and flags away. **Every Team must clean up their sideline after each game.**
