Rules for regular season play:

Games will be played at Chula Vista High School. Standings for the regular season will be based on the ten point system; six points for a win, three points for a tie, zero points for a loss, one point for a shutout, and one point for each goal scored (up to a maximum of 3 points). **Only those teams that complete volunteer and referee assignments are eligible for post-season play-offs,**

The home team is listed first on the schedule and has the choice of sides of the field. The referee provides the game ball. Properly completed lineup cards (date, division, age group, team name & number, **all** players listed in numeric order (present or not) with both first & last names), and registration forms must be presented prior to the start of the game.

Coaching shall be done only by the designated coaches, who may coach only from the side of the field designated for their team within the coaches box. **Coaches and spectators must stay behind the coaches box.** A team that cannot begin play within 10 minutes of the scheduled start time shall forfeit the game. A forfeit will be scored as 1 - 0. No "scrimmage" game shall be played after a forfeit.

Only the Commissioner may make the decision to cancel games for due to rain or heat. Coaches will be notified as soon as possible of any cancellations. Check the website at www.ayso290.org for cancellation notices.

Teams scheduled for the first game of the day must report to the field to set up the goals and flags **one hour** prior to game time. Teams scheduled for the last game of the day must put the goals back against the fences (**face of the goals towards the fence**) and take the nets and flags back to the referee tents. **All teams are required to clean up the field sidelines after their game.**
